

Regulating Water Pressure

Water Pressure Regulating Valve and Ball Valves



A water pressure regulator is recommended when water pressure is more than 80psi. It holds the pressure below a preset level to make it less likely that high water pressure spikes could cause water to faucet supply lines and appliances to leak. Pressure regulators are an inexpensive insurance against possible expensive water damage.

Having a positive shutoff at the main water supply of your home is also important. A ¼ turn positive shutoff brass ball valve can make it easy to turn the water off to your home in case of an emergency.
